This term I will be learning to...

In English, I will be learning to:

- Check that the text types makes sense, discuss understanding, and explaining the meaning of words in context
- Use the diagonal and horizontal strokes that are needed to join letters and understand which letters, when adjacent to one another, are best left un-joined
- Organise paragraphs around a theme
- Extend the range of sentences with more than one clause by using a wider range of conjunctions
- Text types:
 - Stories from familiar settings
 - recounts and Adventure and Mystery Stories

As a Mathematician, I will be learning to:

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number
- Read Roman numerals to 12 (I to XII) and know that over time, the numeral system changed to include the concept of zero and place value
- Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods and columnar addition and subtraction
- Recall multiplication for multiplication tables 3, 4 and 8 as well as 2, 5 and 10
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value and complex addition and subtraction
- Estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute

As a Scientist, I will be learning to:

- Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat
- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions

As a Historian, I will be learning about:

- Being aware of Julius Caesar's attempted invasion in 55-54 BC
- The Roman Empire by AD 42 and the power of its army
- The successful invasion by Claudius and conquest, including Hadrian's Wall
- British resistance, led by Boudicca

In PSHE, I will be learning to:

- Understand the need for and the importance of rules in school, home and society
- Show an understanding of how rules are made in society



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This term I will be learning to...

As an Artist, I will be learning to:

- Create sketch books to record my observations and use them to review and revisit ideas
- Improve my mastery of art and design techniques, including sculpture with a range of materials

As a Musician, I will be learning to:

- Play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using my voice and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression
- Improvise and compose music for a range of purposes

In Physical Education, I will be learning to:

- Apply basic principles suitable for attacking and defending
- Play competitive games, including football, hockey, netball and Tag rugby.
- Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance throughout athletics and gymnastics

In German, I will be learning to talk about:

- Aspects of the spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding
- The patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words

As a Designer, I will be learning to:

- Use research and develop design criteria to inform the design of innovative, functional, appealing products that are fit for purpose, aimed at particular individuals or groups.

In Computing, I will be learning to:

- Select, use and combine a variety of software (including internet services) on a range of digital devices
- Design and create a range of programs, systems and content that accomplish given goals, including collecting, analysing, evaluating and presenting data and information

In Religious Education, I will be learning to:

- Discuss 'Why do people pray?' through questions such as:
 - Which places are special and why?
 - What makes some places sacred?
 - If God is everywhere, why go to a place of worship?
 - Should religious buildings be sold to feed the starving?
