KS2 SATs RESULTS

On Tuesday 10th July at 7.30am the DfES released to schools across the country the results of the Year 6 Statutory Testing that takes place every summer term. Below is the grid to show how Upton-upon-Severn has scored within these tests for 2018.

PERCENTAGE REACHING THE EXPECTED STANDARD IN ENGLAND:

English writing (teacher assessed)	78%	85%	7% above National
English reading test	75%	96%	21% above National
SPAG	78%	93%	15% above National
Maths test	76%	85%	9% above National
Combined (Reading, Writing and Maths)	64%	78%	14% above National

As you can see these results show that our school has achieved very highly this year. These assessments inform parents of their child's progress in their learning development within school.
