Please find overleaf a brief outline of the curriculum content for this term. Our topic this half term is 'A Bridge Over Upton'. In English we will be studying Clockwork by Phillip Pullman.

<b><u>Homework</u></b>	English and maths homework will now be given out on a Wednesday, to be handed in on the following Monday.
<b><u>Year 6</u></b>	Spellings will be sent home on a Thursday, the results of which can be found in the children's home school diaries.
<b><u>20-30 minutes</u></b>	Reading should also be worked on at home throughout the week and recorded in the Home Liaison Book.

### **P.E**

Year 6 children will have many opportunities this term to take part in sporting activities and to represent their school. In particular we have rounders, cross country and swimming competitions to look forward to. We therefore would kindly ask that they have the correct PE kit and suitable footwear, preferably trainers, for playing on the grass in all weather conditions. Children will be asked to wear shorts in games lessons from this term onward and therefore the appropriate blue school shorts should be worn. Friday morning will be an outdoor session of either netball or football and Monday afternoon will be an indoor session of dance or gym. Children who are missing PE kit will not be permitted to take part. P.E is a requirement of the National Curriculum and therefore non-participation is taken very seriously.
