Year 6 children will have many opportunities this term to take part in sporting activities and to represent their school. In particular we have rugby, athletics and football competitions to look forward to. We therefore would kindly ask that they have the correct PE kit and suitable footwear, preferably trainers, for playing on the grass in all weather conditions. Friday afternoon will be an outdoor session of either rugby or hockey and Monday afternoon will be an indoor session of gym. Children will be asked to wear shorts in PE lessons this term and therefore the appropriate blue school shorts should be worn. Gymnastics, using the apparatus, must be done in bare feet. Children who are missing PE kit will not be permitted to take part. P.E is a requirement of the National Curriculum and therefore non-participation is taken very seriously.
