Dear Parents/Carers,

It is lovely to be back after the Easter break. The children have all started the term with a very positive attitude to learning. Our topic this half-term is 'Paper Dragons and Red Rabbits'. Reading

As always, it is essential that your child reads daily at home to support their reading development. Please try to ensure that you hear your child read each night focussing on intonation, pace and pausing at punctuation to develop a love of reading.

Homework

English and Maths homework will continue to be sent home on a Wednesday for return on a Monday. Late homework does result in a loss of playtime to complete the work. Spelling homework will continue to be sent home each Friday and tested the following Friday, scores below 7 will also result in loss of playtimes to learn the spelling words. Daily reading and revision of all times tables up to 12 x 12 should also be worked on at home throughout the week.
