



CURRICULUM INFORMATION - Autumn Term 2019 Class 1

Welcome to Class 1! The children and I are settling into Class 1 quickly and have begun our work on our topic of 'Houses and Homes'. We will be reading traditional tales and using them for our topic work this term.

Reading:

Please read with your child as often as possible and fill in their Home Liaison Book with the title, and, if possible, a comment. Reading with your child is the most important way to help your child's education at this stage. We will check their books each day and encourage them to change books independently.

Phonics and spellings:

We will have a 20 minute lesson each day. Your child will continue to bring spellings home to learn and these will link to work from class, and will range from 5 -15 in number each week.

PE:

This will be on Mondays in the hall and on Tuesdays outside. Children may wish to bring a tracksuit to wear for outdoor PE when the weather gets cooler, as well as their indoor shorts and T-shirt.

Forest School: Children will have Forest School on Friday afternoons. Please remember suitable clothing including long sleeves, long trousers and wellies.

Homework: English and Mathematics homework are given out on a Wednesday and are to be handed in on a Monday.
