



CURRICULUM INFORMATION - Spring Term 2020 Class 2

Happy New Year! It has been lovely to see the children back after Christmas and to hear about their holidays. I would very much like to thank you all for my wonderful presents. Our topic this half term is 'Poles Apart' and we will be learning about cold climates.

Reading:

Please continue to read with your child as often as possible and fill in their reading record with the book title, and, if possible, a comment. Reading with your child is the most important way to help your child's education at this stage and the more reading practice they have, the better! I will remind children to change their completed books each day and encourage them to do this independently.

Phonics and spellings:

We will have a spelling session each day. Your child will continue to bring spellings home to learn and these will link to work from class, and will range from 5 -15 in number each week.

P.E.:

This will be on Thursdays outside and on Mondays in the hall. Children may wish to bring a tracksuit to wear for outdoor P.E. as the weather is cold, as well as their indoor shorts and T-shirt. Forest School will continue on Wednesday afternoon.

Homework:

Homework links, wherever possible, to the work we are doing in class. It is therefore really important that this is completed and handed in on a Monday

Year 2 15 minutes	Reading, spellings, a weekly English activity, and a weekly maths activity. Specific English and Maths homework handed out on Wednesday to be returned on Monday Spellings will be in the Home Liaison Book on Thursdays to be assessed the following Thursday.
