
This sheet has been designed to further some learning opportunities in curricular areas additional to those on our online protocol.

Talk about and record the things they are worried about on the clouds of attached sheet. Record what they are excited about on the rainbow. Talk about any possible solutions to the worries on the cloud and support any concerns - who could they talk to? You could visually show their worries float away if your child feels happy that their concern has been dealt with or hold on to it so it could be addressed at a later date.</p>	<p>You have probably seen and maybe drawn lots of rainbows recently.
