### What I should already know:

- What a king or queen is
- That our queen today is Elizabeth II.
- That life today is different to life in the past

### What I need to know:

- What the responsibilities of a monarch are
- How it is decided who becomes the next monarch
- To compare what is the same and what is different about Queen Elizabeth II and Queen Victoria, and the times of their reigns
- How to search sources (photos, paintings etc.) for clues

### Key Vocabulary:

**Compare** – To look at two (or more!) things and talk about what is the same and what is different about them

**Past** – The time before now (the present day)

**Change** – How things are different over time

**Royal** – To be part of the family of the king or queen

**Monarch** – The head of state; the name for a king or queen

**Palace** – The home of the monarch

**Reign** – The time during which a king or queen rules

**Victorians** – The name for the people who lived in the UK when Queen Victoria was on the throne
